A NOTE FROM THE FINANCE COMMITTEE

We started the year with a challenging outlook: a deficit of \$93,000 from 2023, a proposed budget for 2024 that with a realistic view of income yielded a deficit of \$171,000, as well as some major building repairs to our boiler and sewer systems with a cash outlay of \$36,500.

But please, don't stop reading.

With a lot of prayers and work from your leaders, a new budget for 2024 was proposed that reflects our current reality with room for God's blessings. To bring spending in line with expected income, some tough decisions were made such as eliminating the Children's Minister position, reducing all staff and clergy salaries, and making reduction in all other categories. We also received our first payment from the Alliance Center for Education as they continue working through their punch list in preparation for classes to begin (yes, they are moving forward).

As we continue through 2024, we believe there are 3 avenues that will move us towards financial well-being: Continue to find ways to grow our facility usage income, continue to manage well our facility and program expenses, and continue to encourage participation by members and friends (that's you) in the giving of tithes and offerings.

How Can You Help?

To meet our budget for the year, congregational giving needs to average \$7,500 per week. We are off to a good start; congregational giving for the first quarter averaged \$7,577. Thank you to those who have given generously to the church to make this happen. No gift is too small. We all can make a difference together.

If you can give over and above your regular giving to help offset the unexpected major repairs, thank you. Please mark your gift for "Major Repairs" so we can correctly "match" the funds.

Consider making your gift through electronic fund transfer (https://secure.myvanco.comjYPJ6/home). Gifts can also be made through cash, check, or text (833-718-0142). We can also accept stock and other asset transfers.

Again, we thank those who have given generously and consistently, and for them a giving statement is enclosed. If you have not had an opportunity to give, we encourage you to take the next step and partner with us in mission and ministry. As the Apostle Paul offers "Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full—pressed down,

shaken together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap." Luke 6:38
