Join us Wednesday, September 23rd, at 7:00 p.m. to sing along with Jimmy New!

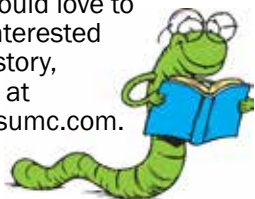
PLEASE SUPPORT VIRTUAL CROP HUNGER WALK.
