# Did you know

Were you here on November 4, 1990? That All Saint's Day was special in the life of our church. It was the day that 10 beautiful Memorial Stained Glass Windows were dedicated in our Sanctuary. Aside from the windows on the side wall, there is one at the back of the Sanctuary and two located within the sacristy. Twelve loving families generously provided the funding for the windows.

The windows were designed to depict the Life of Christ. Next time you are in the Sanctuary, see if you can find these special symbols.

- The Christ Symbol these are the Greek letters chi and rho, which are the first and last letters in the Greek word for Christ.
- Creation the hand of God reaching down to create the Land, Sea, Sun, Moon, and stars.
- Nativity the star of the East shines down on the manger; the Christ symbol in the manger reminds us of the humbleness of his birth.
- Baptism the Dove was present at Christ's baptism; the shell and water represent his baptism as well.
- Choosing the Disciples the Christ symbol is draped with a fishnet alluding to Christ's statement about making "fishers of men."
- The Triumphal Entry the Cross of Christ and the Palm branches represent His triumphal entry into Jerusalem on what we now call "Palm Sunday."
- The Last Supper the Chalice is shown with the Christ symbol representing the Lord's Supper; the 12 crosses surrounding the cup represent the 12 disciples.
- The Crucifixion the red cross symbolizes the blood of Christ shed for our sins; the Crown of Thorns represents His suffering and death.
- The Resurrection the Stone is rolled away representing the empty tomb and Christ's victory over death; the lilies represent the recurring victory over death for all Christians.
- The Fish one of the earliest symbols of Christianity. Be sure to see the Fish across the bottom of the Crucifixion and Resurrection windows.
- The Ascension Christ's Ascension into heaven is represented by a Chariot of Fire
- Pentecost the Dove represents the Holy Spirit coming down to give new life and birth for the Christian church.




