As we enter the season of the year in which we often speak of gratitude and thanksgiving, I'm reminded of Psalm 24:1 "The Earth is the Lord's and everything in it." This scripture teaches me that Christian stewardship is defined as caring for God's resources to give glory to God and care for God's created. I want to offer a special thank you to Doug Dennison, David Lisk, Jr., Kenn Bullock and David Lisk, Sr. for their care and attention to the stewardship presentation this past Sunday. Several folks asked for a simplified version of our current need. To that end, here is a summary.

The Future....

Short-term Goal

Raise \$88,000 to address the operations and building fund shortfall plus to take care of some lingering maintenance issues during the last quarter of the year (October-December). The donations will be broken down as follows:

Building Fund

 Raise \$14,100 to fund the account for the rest of the year through the first quarter of 2020 - less than \$1.25 a day per member (an extra \$115 per giving unit by the end of 2019). Please denote: To Building Fund in the check memo

Operating Fund

 Raise an additional \$73,900, (translates to an extra \$500 in donations per giving unit between now and the end of the year)




