"LIGHT TO THE COMMUNITY" UPDATE

Recently, St. Andrew's UMC began hosting a program called "Get Ready with Words". This program meets from 10:00 -12:00 each Wednesday morning in our FLC. St. Andrew's is partnering with Community School of the Arts, the Library, and Discovery Place to offer a program to help preschool children get ready for school by building an appropriate vocabulary. This "mommy and me" program is designed to make sure that these preschool kids are beginning school with a strong base of vocabulary words, so they are not already behind grade level with reading.



The Montclaire neighborhood was a targeted neighborhood by this grant funded program and St. Andrew's UMC was lucky enough to be approached about hosting this wonderful program. We, as a church,

have a reputation for being a hospitable neighborhood church. We get the chance to welcome into our church up to 50 preschool children and their parents each week. This is a great opportunity to be a light to our neighborhood.

It would be easy to just open our doors to this program and do nothing more. The program would still be successful. The Library, Community School of the Arts, and Discovery Place are doing a fantastic job offering a program to these families. We have simply been asked for space. However, I am asking that we do more than just open our doors. There are ways that we can be involved in this program as a church. We are looking for folks to be weekly "hosts" for this group. Simply being present for the group and helping them in whatever way may be needed. This could mean getting them tape, pencils, TV's, etc. It could also simply mean just pointing folks to the restroom. Many weeks, it will simply mean walking around and being hospitable and welcoming to the families we have welcomed into our building. There is also a chance to provide a snack for the group each week. Most weeks so far, this has been juice, fruit, raisins, and other simply, but healthier snack options. If you are interested in volunteering for this program, please see Kevin Ward or Ruth Mauldin. If you are interested just seeing what the program is all about, feel free to stop by any Wednesday morning and say hello. I can tell you from experience, these first few weeks of the program we have been a light to our neighborhood, but the light our neighborhood is bringing into our church is also shining bright.
