# FROM THE FINANCE COMMITTEE



As we move into the final two months of the year, the Finance Committee finds it necessary to bring you an update on the financial condition of the church. In the words of a Finance Committee member, we find ourselves in a situation that needs immediate attention. Let me explain. At present, St. Andrew's is experiencing a cash-flow problem caused by a couple of reasons: a shortage in giving; as usually happens during the summer months, the church experiences a lag in giving, but then giving returns to normal during the fall. However, that has not occurred this year. In fact, our giving during September and October has been the lowest of the year. There are quite a few families who are behind in their pledges. Secondly, expenses incurred due to an aging building and HVAC problems have pushed our budget to the limit and beyond. The Finance Committee has been looking at ways to reduce the annual budget. Ministry and program needs are already at a minimum, and the maintenance needs of the church will continue to increase. Utility bills will also need to be paid. If we continue in our present trajectory, the only expenses we will be able to cut in 2017 will be in the area of staff and we surely don't want to do that unless it is absolutely necessary. We appreciate the fact that many of you are giving sacrificially. It is our prayer that those who are behind in their giving will attempt to bring their giving upto-date and that others will be able to help us meet our need as has been done so often in the past. Thank you.


