


The CHATTER

Have you ever faced a challenge or obstacle where you found yourself not only without a map, but also in a fast moving river without the proverbial paddle? This is not unlike what Lewis and Clark discovered as they explored the lands to the west of the Mississippi. Eventually they ran into the Rocky Mountains and there were no maps and all their assumptions and experiences had to be adapted to the new surroundings and circumstances. This is the same challenge that many

churches face as society changes daily where churches search for continued relevancy in people's lives.

To help St. Andrew'S UMC navigate the "new waters" of today's world, we would like to read, study, and discuss the book "Canoeing the Mountains" by Tod Bolsinger. Tod uses the example of Lewis and Clark's adaptations to the challenges they faced to the challenges we face as a church as we travel into uncharted territories. We continually discover that our previous successes and methods don't seem to be as effective as they once were.



We decided to embark on this adventure with the Administrative Council Membership for 2020 to help

us build leadership understanding and capacity. To expand our reach to the entire congregation, we wish to open this opportunity up to all members, guests, occasional attendees, and even casual by standers to join us. This will be an adventure you don't want to miss!

To make it available to all, we will offer this in two sessions, 10:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. in the Commons Room (#1), on the 3rd Tuesday each month: February 18th, March 17th, April 21st, May 19th, June 16th, September 15th, October 20th, and November 17th. We plan to cover roughly two chapters per month, so the meetings should last between 60-90 minutes. This shouldn't interfere with any of the other Bible Studies and it provides us with some soak time to not only discuss the book but also discuss how it might be applicable to our ministry at St. Andrew's.

We will be sending out information about purchasing the book and signing up in the coming few weeks. So pull out your hiking boots and outback gear and join the adventure! We need you to join our journey into the future!
