MISSIONS COMMITTEE'S LENTEN CHALLENGE

When we give up something for Lent, we usually think of some degree of fasting. The spiritual discipline of fasting is the practice of giving up one's time, money, food or an activity in order to devote more to God. We pray that during the season of Lent, you will practice the discipline of fasting and that you will spend more time in prayer and meditation. We also hope that you will consider those who are in a constant fast from food due to poverty. The Missions Committee is challenging St. Andrew's UMC to donate two TONS of food for Loaves and Fishes during the season of Lent. To achieve that goal, 100 units (individuals or families) need to bring 6 pounds of food per week or 200 units bring 3 pounds of food per week to the bins in the Narthex and the Family Life Center. That is a meager goal for St. Andrew's, but will mean so much to some hungry families in our community. It may be an interesting activity for your family to figure how many pounds of food you eat per day or week.



Several members of St. Andrew's have been tutoring students at Montclaire School in various ways. One of the programs used is the Heart Math program, which is a tutorial. This program helps students gain more confidence in their math skills which results in a more successful student. Students are identified by their teachers at the first of the school year. The Heart staff organizes students with tutors and the time they can be tutored. There is a training session for the volunteers before you meet with your student. All materials, manipulatives, and lesson plans are provided for the tutor. A Heart staff person is available at each session to assist if need be and offer suggestions. They are the liaison between the school staff and the tutor. Tutors meet with their students for 30 minutes per session. This is one way to help children become successful so think about giving some time to Heart.
