


Saturday, October 17th 3:00-6:00 p.m.

WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY OCTOBER 6TH.



COLLEGE PREP PROGRAM

St. Andrew's and Dilworth UMC youth programs will be offering 2 college preparation programs.

October 4th – "Breaking the Myths of Getting Into College" At St. Andrew's UMC

Our young people hear all kinds of myths about what it takes to get into college. The truth is, there are lots of colleges out there, and ultimately a college that is right for each of our young people.

We will have ...

- A high school guidance counselor whose focus is college admission.
- College admissions counselors from a couple of different schools.
- A college financial aid counselor to help understand some of the myths of the money side of college.

These folks will form a panel and each share what they believe are some of the myths of college admissions and going to college. We will then break into smaller groups for some more focused question and answer sessions with each of the panel members. The middle school youth will go with the High school guidance counselor to have more discussion on what they can do to better prepare for high school (Middle school parents are welcome to join this group as well). High school youth and parents will have the option of going with one of the admissions counselors or the financial aid counselor.

This program is for parents, middle school youth, and high school youth.

November 1st – "How Do I Keep Growing in My Faith at College?" At Dilworth UMC

Statistics show that our young people abandon their faith at alarmingly high rates once they get to college. The focus of this program will be on how to keep connected to faith once students get to college.

We will have ...

- College students who are active participants in religious life organizations in college
- Campus ministry leaders from several different schools.

This program will start off with a panel, with each of the panel members getting a chance to share. We will then break into smaller focus groups to have discussion on the challenges of keeping your faith in college. Parents and youth will have a chance to ask more probing questions in regards to some of the real hurdles of keeping your faith in college and how to connect to a student ministry.

This program is also open to parents, middle school youth, and high school youth.
