


YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULT MISSIONS

We had another successful summer of mission work here at St. Andrew's UMC. Thank you to all of the adult

volunteers who chaperoned these trips, to all the church members who prayed for us while we were away, and all of the church members who supported us in our fundraising efforts!

This was the first year we had a college age mission trip! We took a group of 10 folks to New York, NY, in May of 2015! We worked at the





checking out. In our 3 days of mission work, the WSCAH processed close to 2,500 clients. In the evenings, we spent time touring and eating our way through NYC. Saturday, we spent an entire day touring and seeing the sights. It was a very successful trip that we plan to offer again in 2016. The plans for 2016 are

to go to Chicago, IL, and have a similar trip. The tentative dates for that trip are May 10th-16th.

We returned for a 3rd year to Wilmington, NC, and worked again with Wilmington Area Rebuilding Ministries. We took 34 folks from St. Andrew's and once again worked with Dilworth UMC for this trip. Among the 45 overall participants, we collectively logged around 900 service hours with WARM! Our work included repairing/replacing



floors in 10 rooms, building a wheel chair ramp, tearing out an old deck and replacing it, replacing a set of steps, removing old counters and installing new countertops, installing new sinks, replacing an exterior door so a wheel chair could fit through, lots of yard work,

and much, much more! Our youth and adults worked very hard to help out 4 different homeowners in the Wilmington Area.

For 2016, we hope to add a local mission week to our mission projects. Since we are adding a new mission experience, we will most likely return to Wilmington, NC, for a 4th summer for our off site mission project.


